A four-part series of half-day workshops is being offered to teach you and your team how to implement NIST 800-171 and become compliant with its requirements.

Cybersecurity experts will present a robust agenda of topics that include:

- Overview of DoD cyber regulations, the cyber threat landscape, and preparing for change
- Guidance on risk management, NIST 800-171 self-assessment and compliance
- Navigating the Supplier Performance Risk System (SPRS)
- Policies and procedures documentation & Incident Response Plan development
- Technical remediations and System Security Plan development

Each week, the training topics are presented for different organizational responsibilities including business owners, operations, quality, HR and IT.

The four workshops begin the last week of April and are held online every other week. Seating is limited!
